

NORTHLAND CHAPTER ACSM 2017 STUDENT TRAVEL AWARD

(new round - announced March 5, 2017)

The Northland Chapter of the American College of Sports Medicine (NACSM) is pleased to offer up to two (2), \$500 travel awards to student members of NACSM. The purpose of the award is to provide assistance to help fund travel expenses accrued by selected student applicants to present their scholarly work at the ACSM 64th Annual Meeting, 8th World Congress on Exercise is Medicine® and World Congress on the Basic Science of Exercise and the Brain, which will take place in Denver, CO from May 30-June 3, 2012. REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must be an undergraduate/graduate student in good standing at the time of submission of the abstract for the ACSM annual meeting and must have been an NACSM Student (grad or undergrad) member at the time the abstract was submitted.
2. Abstract must have the applicant as the first author and the abstract must be accepted by the program committee for presentation at the ACSM 64th annual meeting (e.g. free communication/slide, free communication/poster, clinical case study). See #7 below for additional information on verifying acceptance prior to receipt of travel award)
3. Applicant must have a faculty sponsor, who must sign the application indicating that the student is in good standing and that the student is responsible for the research abstract being presented.
4. Applicant must submit a letter (no longer than one page) describing: a) the importance of the research being presented; b), how the research experience influences his/her future career; c), their involvement in the NACSM
5. Scientific quality will be the primary criterion for selection. Following quality, priority will be given to students who have not previously received a travel award from NACSM.
6. Students who are already receiving funds from NACSM to attend the ACSM conference (e.g quiz bowl winners, Presidents Cup) are not eligible to receive the award.
7. **Applications must be received electronically by April 1, 2017. Applicants must supply verification from ACSM that the abstract has been accepted.**
8. Send to bradley.bowser@sdstate.edu with subject line as "NACSM Student Travel Award".
9. Announcement of award recipient will be made by **April 15, 2017.**
10. Selection of the awards will be conducted by a committee made up of the NACSM Student Activities and Research Director and 2 NACSM board members.
11. In order to receive funding, award winners will be required to submit receipts verifying up to \$500 in allowable expenses directly resulting from presentation at the meeting. Examples of allowable expenses are travel, lodging, conference registration, meals and cost of preparing poster for display.
